Learning area

2: Methods and techniques for treatment and rehabilitation

Learning objectives

Knowledge and understanding

. Development of relational and communication skills needed in the relationship with the patient. Identify the appropriate communication modalities and challenges in the communication and relations with patients (children, adolescents, adults, elderly persons) with different clinical conditions

. Identify the appropriate communication modalities and challenges in the communication and relationship with patients belonging to different socio-cultural contexts

Applying knowledge and understanding

. Development of relational and communication skills needed in the relationship between the psychologist and the healthcare team

. Identify the appropriate communication modalities and challenges in the communication and relationship with other members of the healthcare team.

Contents

The laboratory offers discussions, exercises and practical applications related to the work of the psychologist in the specific healthcare field with a particular focus on good communication practices and the care of the relationship with the patient and the healthcare team.

Detailed program

The laboratory includes 8 modules lasting 3 hours.

Each module will deepen a topic and will consist of a theoretical part, a presentation of a clinical case and the related exercise.

Topics:

STEP 1: Applications of basic communication strategies at health level in highly complex situations. The theme of PAIN.

STEP 2: Communication in pediatrics: accompanying the sick child and his family in diagnostic and treatment practices.

STEP 3: Communication in pediatrics: the complexity of working with the adolescent patient and his family.

STEP 4: Communication with patients from different cultural backgrounds: how many medicines?

STEP 5: Supporting couples in the paths of medically assisted procreation.

STEP 6: Informed consent: what is it? The drafting of the medical record and the relationship with the medical-health team.

STEP 7: The hospital institution: communication between operators.

STEP 8: Between body and psyche: the psychologist in the hospital.

Prerequisites

A basic knowledge of the technique of the psychological interview and of the general laws of communication (verbal and non-verbal) is assumed. Please note that this laboratory is particularly suitable for those with basic knowledge concerning health psychology.

Teaching methods

The laboratory is composed of exercises and classroom discussions based on the clinical cases presentation, moves and documentary watching concerning the health psychology field.

The practical exercises will specifically include:

- Review of medical records and discussion of cases in groups and with the teacher;

- Role-playing and simulations of complex clinical situations and clinical interviews

The exercises will be supported by theoretical aspects and by the presentation of scientific articles aimed at directing and stimulating the student to develop the awareness and critical vision of the multiple modes of intervention in health psychology.

The discussed material will then be made available, as will the lesson slides.

The laboratory is in Italian language.

During the COVID-19 emergency period, the teaching methods will be defined and updated on the basis of the University rules.

Assessment methods

Oral exam that includes the discussion concerning the themes discussed during the laboratory.

Textbooks and Reading Materials

The bibliography will be provided by the teacher with Articles discussed in class.
