Gynecological epidemiology. The benign gynecological diseases. Gynecological examination and diagnostic investigations. Menstrual cycle fisiopatologia, from menarche to menopause. Endometriosis. Pelvic pain and dysmenorrhea. The most common gynecological malformations. Genito-urinary infections and sexually transmitted diseases. Vulvodynia.
