Course title

The fundamental concepts of psychoanalysis

Topics and course structure

The course will first reconstruct the concept of consciousness in some of the key authors of philosophical modernity, and then address the theoretical revolution operated by Freud with the founding of psychoanalytic theory. The fundamental concepts of psychoanalysis will be analysed in Freud's text *Introduction to Psychoanalysis*.
