Course title

Vital and formative effects of contemporary organizations

Topics and course structure

What is "pedagogical" in organizations? What is a contemporary organization?

The course aims to describe the structure of contemporary organizations, the persistence of a modern organizational model, the notion of device and – above all – the effects that all this has on our lives.

Overcoming the false dilemma – we are at the service of the organizations or they are at our service – we intend to provide a truly innovative and different pedagogical vision on / for current organizations.

Objectives

The lessons include:

- to provide knowledge about the pedagogy and philosophy of training;
- to illustrate the many interpretative and explanation models of education and training;
- to legitimize a pedagogical point of view in/about organizations.

In addition to information, lessons wont to train the student in the following skills:

- to be able to recognize social and cultural representations, theoretical models of education and training in the organizations of yesterday and today;
- to know how to pedagogically analyze the contexts of intervention aimed in particular at adults;
- (possibly) to know how to design experiences, operational tools and styles of pedagogical intervention with today's adults.

Methodologies

Lessons will be proposed:

- frontal moments ;
- reading and/or commentary of significant texts/passages;
- watching significant movies/scenes:
- clinical pedagogical exercises.
