Teaching methods

The teaching activity will be carried out face-to-face.
Lectures will alternate with group discussions of clinical material.
Clinical cases will be used through texts and videos.

Assessment methods

The exam will be carried out in presence. The exam consists of a written test with 30 multiple choice questions and two open questions. The test will focus on the entire program of the course. Students who pass the written test (minimum 18) will have access to an optional oral test.

The questions are aimed at ascertaining the effective acquisition of both theoretical knowledge and practical-clinical skills relating to the different models of communication and acceptance of the diagnosis.

The evaluation criteria are: the correctness of the answers and the mastery of the models and techniques learned during the course.
