The neuropsychomotor development in the first year of life:

- neurobehavioral examination
- · general movements

Neurodevelopmental disorders:

• intellectual developmental disorder, communication disorders, autism spectrum disorders, attention-defict and hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), specific learning disorder, motor disorders (developmental coordination disorder, stereotypic movement disorder, tic disorders)

Psychiatric disorders:

- bipolar and related disorders
- depressive disorders
- · anxiety disorders
- · obsessive-compulsive and related disorders
- trauma- and stressor-related disorders

Behavioural and eating disorders:

- · disruptive, impulse-control, and conduct disorder
- · feeding and eating disorders
- · elimination disorders

Other conditions:

- early-onset psychosis
- problematic internet use (internet gaming disorder)
- personality disorders (borderline personality disorder)

Somatic symptom disorder and related disorders

Child neurology:

- childhood epilepsies, febrile seizures
- headaches
- movement disorders: tics, chorea, athetosis, tremor, dystonia, ataxia
- · encephalopathies: cerebral palsy
- muscular dystrophies: Duchenne and Becker
- neuropathies: Guillain-Barré
