Aims

Side by side with the family pediatrician (1: 1) in the daily work of taking care of the little patient according to principles based on scientific evidence and on the definition of priorities

Contents

anamnesis, pediatric physical examination, approach to the setting

Detailed program

- OBSERVATION of the ongoing relationship with the child and his family: listening, promoting the therapeutic alliance and empowering parents.
- KNOWLEDGE OF THE INDICATIONS relating to prevention, diagnosis, behavioral advice, treatment prescriptions
 - ACQUISITION of the need / ability to inform and make the patient aware of his or her history of illness and treatment
- KNOWLEDGE of the methods of relationship and contact with the forms of assistance present in the surrounding area
