### Learning objectives

Provide knowledge of EU administrations.

Develop the approaches and methodologies of juridical analysis of EU administrative law questions.

#### Contents

Lessons and workshop in class will focus on EU administrative law, which includes analysis of the main forms of administration through which policy is delivered.

#### Prerequisites

#### **Teaching methods**

Lesson, exposition of cases by students, debate on the issues arising from the analysis of the cases.

#### **Assessment methods**

Test on the general part of the programme made by true/false or multiple answers questions and one open question; in-class presentation of some in-depth topics, evaluated in terms of knowledge, understanding and presentation of the chosen subject.

Alternatively: final oral examination aimed at testing knowledge of the entire course programme.
