Learning area

Learning objectives

The course provides students with a critical understanding of the Italian Constitutional Law and leads them to a complete knowledge of the text of the Italian Constitution.

Contents

The course covers the whole of the Italian Constitutional Law (fundamental rights and duties and public powers' organization).

Detailed program

Introduction. The legal phenomenon. Forms of state and forms of government. The Italian Constitution and its fundamental principles. Brief Italian constitutional history. Italy and the European Union. The constitutional organization: the electoral body, the Parliament, the Executive, the President of the Republic, the central administration, regional and local government, the Constitutional Court, the Judiciary. The fundamentals rights and duties. The sources of the legal system.

Particular insights will be dedicated to the profiles of Italian constitutional and institutional history and to the most recent developments of the system of sources of law.

Prerequisites

Teaching methods

Lectures. Case studies.

Assessment methods

Written pre-selection and then oral exam (on the same day).

In May 2024 students can take an optional intermediate written examination (chapters I-X).
