Course title

Geografia e didattica della geografia

Topics and course structure

The course aims to introduce students to human geography and its most recent issues by attempting to communicate the richness and breadth of the subject. Human geography studies the relationships between human communities and the natural environment in their territorial expression. The course addresses some of the central themes of the discipline: culture, languages and religions, ethnic geography, gender, development and change, urban systems, and the political organisation of space. During the course, particular emphasis will be placed on the themes taught in primary school and how to get them appropriated by children. An attempt will also be made to reflect on the ideological role of teaching geography at school and the need to adopt a critical attitude towards geographical 'discourse'.

The course will be delivered in Italian.

By means of this teaching, with constant and participative attendance of the lectures and the Laboratory connected to the course, we intend to PROMOTE the following learning, in terms of
