## COURSE SYLLABUS

### Principles of Environmental Law

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#### Aims

The course aims to outline a map, although incomplete, of the national, regional and local administrative organization, and of the relationship between the same complexes organizers and European institutions. Furthermore, the course will offer a brief introduction to the administrative competence as provided in environmental law.

#### Contents
