Metodologia Clinica nelle Scienze Infermieristiche

Aims

The course will provide a foundation in knowledge and skills necessary for 1st year nursing students to:

- assess, collect, organize, validate and document patient's data;
- recognize the most important nursing problems and state nursing diagnoses;
- focus ethical aspects of nursing practice.

Contents

Initial nursing assessment: physical examination, history taking, data collection, validation and diagnostic reasoning, ethical issues of nursing practice.

Detailed program

Schools of Lecco, Monza brianza and Sondrio: Nursing assessment is oriented by the Human Processes Nursing Model (MAPU). Diagnosis label statement is oriented by ICNP® terminology.

School of Bergamo: Nursing assessment is oriented by Virginia Henderson's Nursing Theory (14 fundamental needs in their biophysiological, psycho-socio-cultural dimensions). Diagnosis label statement is oriented by NANDA-International®.

By way of example, some diagnostic label will be discussed (class discussion).
