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#### Aims

To know the role of the midwife in the community and their educational competence in the prevention and promotion of gender health.

#### Contents

The course provides the skills for community-based midwifery care and related educational competence in the promotion of gender health and evidence-based family planning, in which the student will be able to implement the care of the woman, the family/couple and the newborn through the Midwifery Partnership, Midwifery Management, ICF classification and Rating Scales

#### Detailed program

The students will be able to plan and to provide an evidence based educational and rehabilitation program to the woman in accordance with the Midwifery Partnership Model, the Midwifery Management, the international Classification Functions and evaluation scales. The midwifery counseling during menopause. Organisational models of the community health services.
