Contents

First part of the course: focus on the educational contexts (e.g., nursery, kindergarten and primary school) in which the psychological development can be promoted and supported. Second part of the course: focus on specific topics (e.g., the development of social cognition and social and emotional competencies) as well as on the efficacy of intervention programs to enhance this development in children.

Prerequisites

Basic knowledge of Developmental Psychology and Educational Psychology .

Teaching methods

Frontal lesson; discussion of case studies, evidence-based outcomes, research instruments, educational validated programs.

Assessment methods

Written test; 3 open questions (10 point for each question)

For students who request, an oral exam can be taken.

The evaluation criteria are: language property and accuracy, contents knowledge of the topics, personal elaboration of the contents, connections between the different topics, critical and reflective ability.
