Course title

Cartesian invention of the space of interiority and Wittgenstein's critique

Topics and course structure

The lessons will first reconstruct the concept of space of interiority proposed by Descartes in *The Metaphysical Meditations*. In a second step, some critiques of this conception will be proposed, particularly those proposed by Wittgenstein in *The Philosophical Investigations* and *In On Certainty*.

Objectives

The aim is to show the philosophical-political *enjeu* of the question of interiority.
