Course title

New Schools, pedagogical activism, outdoor education: experiences and reflections in the history of Education

Topics and course structure

History of education studies speeches about education: it proposes thoughts about past educational theories and models and about practical behaviours and ideal representations of collective imaginary, starting from the study of selected classical masterworks

Objectives

- knowledge of the perspectives and theoretical models related to educational processes with attention to their origin and their historical development.
- reflection on how some dimensions of educational activities have been tackled in the history of pedagogy and educational institutions
- reflection on the images of educator and growth present in Western cultural history

The course aims activate the following skills related to professional profile:

- a. to knowing how to connect theoretical and practical knowledge

b. to be able analyze professional contexts

c. to anticipate the outcomes, consequences and results of interventions also in the dimension of ethic and professional ethic

Assessment methods

The exam consists of a semi-structured written test.

After the correction, The oral exam is at the request of the student. It's an interview on all the exam texts

The trials will evaluate:

- the acquisition of some contents of the history of pedagogy, in particular: the images of growth and care present in the history of pedagogy and education; the reflection on the figure, on the role, on the professional profile of the educator, with attention to some historical periods and to some thinkers who contributed to this debate in a significant way;
- the ability to critically and personally re-elaborate the contents and to reflect on the dimensions of the educational processes with a historical look
