Learning objectives

The course aims primarily at acquiring a good knowledge of the principles and institutions of the legal system.

It is a specific purpose to present the organization and activity of the institutions of the Italian Republic and the European Union; to analyze the relationship between authority and freedom, with reference to the individual and to social groups; to introduce to the study of normative sources and the mechanisms of their production; to highlight the constitutional transformations underway.

Contents

The course aims at building a basic knowledge of the legal orders: the national legal order, the organization of the institutions of the local government and the European legal order. The course is also directed to illustrate the relationship between individuals and institutions – national and European – with regard to the freedoms and the means of their protection.

The attention is also devoted to the most relevant aspects of public economics law: regulation of the market and public intervention in economy.
