## SYLLABUS DEL CORSO

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#### Learning objectives

The course aims at building a basic knowledge of the legal orders: the national legal order, the organization of the institutions of the local government, and the European legal order.

In particular, the course is concerned with the organization and activity of the Italian Government and other public institutions, especially the European Union. The course also provides a juridical and political framework of relations between authorities and rights with particular reference to individuals and social groups' rights.

The aim is also to introduce the study of the legal sources and the mechanisms of their production. The course then focuses on constitutional changes.

#### Contents

This course is concerned with the organization and activity of the Italian Government and other public institutions. The course then focuses on constitutional transformations.

#### Detailed program

- The basics of general public law: the legal system States and governments.
- Sources of public law.
- Outline of Italian constitutional history.
- Constitutional organization of the Italian Republic.

- Regions and local governments.
- Rights and duties of the citizens International relationships of the Italian Republic.
- Public economics law: regulation of the market and public intervention in the economy.

## **Prerequisites**

Knowledge of the legal sources of public law and the general organization of the Italian and European legal order.

## **Teaching methods**

Frontal lessons.

## **Assessment methods**

The examination will be held in oral form in the agreed-upon examination dates on the entire syllabus.

An intermediate examination limited to the topics covered in the lecture may be agreed upon. The second examination will then be held at the end of the course on the remaining part of the programme.

The final examination mark will be determined by the average of the marks in both written tests.

The purpose of the examination is to test understanding of public legal phenomena and the ability to apply the rules to the concrete contexts in which they operate. The examination board will assess the student's level of knowledge, mastery of the subject and understanding of the mechanisms of public law, the degree of knowledge and understanding of the sources of law, the ability to make connections between notions.
