## SYLLABUS DEL CORSO

### Sicurezza sul Terreno

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#### Aims

The course aims to provide students with the basis for a safe approach to outdoor field activities.

#### Contents

The course consists of both theoretical lessons and field activity on different topics related to safety problems during field work activities.

#### Detailed program

The course consists of five mandatory activities to obtain 1 formative credit (CFU):

- 1 - on-line lectures about first aid procedures to adopt during field work.
- 2 - in person lecture held by field guides of **InCordata** school. The lecture will be about proper clothing and equipment; preparation of the field trip; weather forecast; orienting - GPS; safety and rescue in the mountains
- 3 - self medical history to assess the eligibility for field activities, in particular those activities at high altitudes.
- 4 - one-day field trip held by field guides of **InCordata** school.

As detailed in the course syllabus, the course includes both in-person and on-line lectures, and a one-day field trip.
