Aims

The objective of the course is to provide guidance on the dental approach to the geriatric and fragile patient.

Contents

The course expects the student to be able to recognize the elderly or fragile patient who needs an approach, a support plan and a specialized and personalized treatment plan. In particular, the student will be provided with all the information regarding the ability to understand and communication about frailty, oral health problems related to frailty, difficulty accessing care and maintaining oral hygiene. Furthermore, attention will be paid to the relationships between dentists and healthcare facilities.
