Learning objectives

The aim of the course is to provide basic knowledge of the functioning of the European administration and the relationships with national administrations, for the purposes of implementing European policies in Italy.

Furthermore, the course aims to equip students with the necessary tools to develop a critical approach to the currently most debated issues in European administrative law, also with attention to the Green Deal.

Contents

Lessons and workshop in class will focus on EU adminstrative law, which includes analysis of the main forms of administration through which policy is delivered .

Detailed program

Detailed program will be discussed in class during the first lesson and will be then shared on line on the e-learning. Lessons will be held in class. Students will be asked to present materials during the lessons.

The course will be divided into two parts: the first will take place with delivery methods and the second part with interactive methods.
