Course title

Developmental Psychology (A-L)

Topics and course structure

After a brief historical overview of the discipline and reflections on the methodologies mainly adopted, the development of the main psychological dimensions (motor, emotional, affective, cognitive, linguistic, social and moral) will be presented in the light of the main theoretical models and their potential application in the educational school context.

Objectives

The course aims at introducing students to the theoretical models of developmental psychology, considering the psychological development as a complex and multidimensional process engaging the person through the life cycle.

Methodologies

The course will be mainly lecture-based (80%), with also interactive teaching (20%). In addition to lectures, some brainstorming activities and classroom exercises will be offered.
