Aims

The course consists of two modules, with the following aims:

PREVENTIVE AND COMMUNITY DENTISTRY

The course aims to provide students with the tools necessary to arrive at an effective prevention of caries and the main periodontal diseases.

SURGICAL PATHOLOGY AND CLINICAL PROPEDEUTICS

The course aims to provide the basic knowledge of general surgery and common surgical procedures in dental practice

Contents

PREVENTIVE AND COMMUNITY DENTISTRY

Trends in caries disease and relationships with individual, social and environmental characteristics. Evaluation of its incidence and prevalence. Levels and types of prevention. The main prevention strategies applicable to health protection from the point of view of prevention of caries and the onset of dysgnathias.

SURGICAL PATHOLOGY AND CLINICAL PROPEDEUTICS

Principles of technique in general surgery, preoperative patient assessment, fundamentals of cancer surgery, elective surgery and emergency surgery
