### General Medicine

#### Aims

The course aims to provide students with a thorough understanding of the main medical, cardiological, and hematological pathologies relevant to the dental field. Students will learn to identify these pathologies, understand the principles of prevention and treatment, and consider gender differences in presentations and responses to treatments.

## **Teaching form**

## **Assessment method**
