Aims

Gain knowledge on the following topics:

- ? Major diagnostic genetic techniques.
- ? Role of prenatal genetic counselling and prenatal screening.
- ? The most common facial dysmorphism and genetic pediatric conditions.
- ? Role of genetics in the diagnosis and treatment of pediatric cancers.

Contents

The student will achieve basic knowledge about genetic diseases, genetic predisposition to pediatric cancer, use of molecular genetics for precision medicine.

Detailed program

The course will provide the students with basic concepts of the main genetic investigation techniques used both in the context of prenatal diagnosis and to investigate a suspected genetic condition during childhood. Examples of NGS analysis will be shown.

The student will gain knowledge on the most frequent genetic condition that can affect the fetus and the child, underlying the importance of prenatal genetic counselling, the role of dysmorphology in the diagnostic approach of genetic disorders, the importance of the multidisciplinary approach in the follow-up of genetic syndromes.

The course will provide knowledge on the genetics of pediatric tumors, with a focus on pediatric acute lymphoblastic leukemia as a model for the genetic dissection of the pathogenetic events, from the genetic predisposition to the prenatal origin and the dissection of somatic events at clinical diagnosis, to provide a risk-based stratification.
