Obstetrics and Gynecology II

Aims

- · Acquire the ability to perform an anamnesis and objective examination of an obstetric patient.
- Know the physiology of pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium.
- Recognize the main pathologies of pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium and the therapeutic diagnostic approach to these pathologies.
- Perform a prenatal conseling on the main strategies of health promotion in pregnancy and prevention of pregnancy complications.

Contents

The course will provide the student with the opportunity to acquire basic knowledge on the physiology of pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium.

It will also be possible to observe first-hand the assistance provided to the pregnant woman during the phases of labor and spontaneous and surgical delivery. Finally, the student will acquire skills on the diagnosis and treatment of the most frequent obstetric pathologies and clinical emergencies in the delivery room.

Detailed program

- 1. Perform medical interview and physical examination of women.
- 2. Apply recommended prevention strategies to women during pregnancy
- 3. Demonstrate knowledge of preconception care, including the impact of genetics, medical conditions on maternal health and fetal development.
- 4. Explain the normal physiologic changes of pregnancy, including interpretation of common diagnostic studies.

- 5. Describe common problems in obstetrics and clinical interventions in case of obstetrics emergencies.
- 6. Demonstrate knowledge of intrapartum care of the pregnant woman and fetus.
- 7. Demonstrate knowledge of postpartum care.

Prerequisites

Knowledge of the physiology of pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium. Knowledge of the main pathologies of pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium.

Teaching form

The activities will include:

- objective examination of the patients (inpatients, outpatients or medical simulator).
- reports reading.
- case based learning planned in small groups.
- practical exercises with advice of medical simulators.
