Aims

The Semiotics Course on Mannequins carried out with practical exercises with mannequin-simulators is aimed at first learning the techniques of approaching the patient and the main semiological maneuvers to be applied in the physical examination, in preparation for the future professionalizing activity carried out directly over the following years on the patient. The module aims to guide the student in learning the main semiological maneuvers of an internal medicine nature such as the general objective examination, the objective examination of the heart, chest and abdomen. Learning to measure vital parameters is also expected

MEDICAL SEMEIOTICS Physical examination

Collection of anamnesis and compilation of the medical record

- Introduction to the collection of the clinical history by interviewing the patient, focused on:
- Family history
- Physiological history
- Remote pathological history
- Pathological anamnesis next
- Initial approach to the compilation of the medical record

Knowledge of human anatomy and physiology

Teaching form

The didactic activity includes 8 hours of Dispositional Didactics (DE) for all students where the theoretical information for collecting the anamnesis and performing the general and district objective examination will be provided.

This will be followed by hours of Integrative Teaching (DI) carried out in small groups, with the constant presence of the theacher, in order to operationalise theoretical knowledge by applying it on a manikin.
