The aim of the course is to provide the student with a knowledge of specialist subjects that allows, in the course of future professional activity, to be able to suspect / recognize the most important eye diseases, to be able to take even important diagnostic-therapeutic decisions in some cases, to be able to refer ophthalmic patients to the specialist in the sector and, in any case, know how to inform non-ophthalmic patients of the clinical needs for preventive purposes for specific eye diseases of both adults and children.
