Aims

The main purpose of this course is to make known to the medical students what will be their obligations, after graduation. Furthermore, the rights of the young doctor and problems and prospects of the medical profession in the coming years will be presented.

Contents

After their graduation, young doctors enter the job market as professionals, subject to obligations, rules and regulations. In addition to duty and professional ethics, young doctors also need to know their rights and the future prospects of their profession.

Rights and obligations of the young professional - roles and functions of the Medical Board - insurance and pension issues – medical and professional ethics - medical specialties - continuing medical education (CME) - future prospects of the medical profession.
