Aims

Acquiring a deep insight into symptoms, natural history and complication on IBD with particular focus on diagnostic modalities, differential diagnosis and therapeutic strategies.

Contents

The elective course aims to provide a clinical in-depth study of inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD), ranging from etiopathogenesis to clinical presentation, diagnostic techniques, and dedicating ample space to therapeutic management. Both lectures and interactive sessions with the presentation of clinical cases are planned.

Detailed program

The course program includes an initial phase of lectures on the following topics: clinical presentation of IBD; endoscopy and imaging in IBD; medical therapy and surgical therapy. The second part is dedicated to interactive clinical cases, which allow the application of the knowledge acquired, guided by tutors.
