Clerkship in Orthopaedics and Traumatology

Aims

The student will experience the treatment of traumatic and orthopaedic pathologies of muscle-skeletal system. The student will experience the post-operative management of patients who underwent traumatic and orthopaedic surgeries. The student will also be able to assist open or arthroscopic surgeries.

Contents

Provide the attending student with basic knowledge on the management of the orthopedic and traumatized patient. The student will follow an orthopaedic surgeon during the daily practice in the orthopaedic surgical ward, in the outpatient clinic and in orthopaedic emergency room. The student will also be able to attend the surgical theatre.
