Learning area

Disciplines of positive law.

Learning objectives

The course provides students with a critical understanding of the Italian Constitutional Law and leads them to a complete knowledge of the text of the Italian Constitution.

Contents

The course covers the whole of the Italian Constitutional Law (fundamental rights and duties and public powers' organization).

Detailed program

Introduction. The legal phenomenon. Political power. The state. Citizenship. Forms of the state. The constitution. Forms of government. The Italian form of government. The government. The public administration. Parliament. The president of the republic. The regions and local government. The administration of justice. The sources of law. Techniques for resolving antinomies. The individual sources of law. Constitutional justice. Inviolable rights and non-derogable duties.

Prerequisites

None.

Teaching methods

The course will be delivered in 36 lectures of 2 hours each delivered in face-to-face delivery mode. If necessary, 2 lectures of 2 hours each may be delivered in asynchronous remote delivery mode (recorded lectures), at the discretion of the lecturer, to cope with exceptional situations and in order to ensure the continuity of teaching activities. More details will be provided during the semester.

Assessment methods

There are no intermediate tests. The exam will be conducted orally and will consist of an interview on the topics covered in class and in the textbook. To access the oral exam, each student must pass a written pre-selection, with a multiple-choice test (30 questions, 3 answers for each of which only one is correct), which will take place on the same day as the exam. You will enter the oral with at least 18 correct answers. The grade will be given only on the basis of the oral interview.
