Learning objectives

The course aims to provide the student with knowledge relating to the main institutes of private law.

Contents

The course aims to provide clarifications on the main institutions of private law.

Detailed program

Rule and law. The sources of private law. The interpretation of the law. Legal relationship and subjective legal situations. The subjects of the legal relationship. People and companies. Associations, foundations and committees. Facts, deeds and legal transactions. The obligations. The contract. Singular contracts: typical and atypical. Tort law and other sources of obligations. Registration. Prescription.

Family members and relatives. Marriage and civil union. Filiation and adoption. Parental responsibility. Protection and emancipation. Affiliation. The family property regime. Maintenance payments. Legitimate and testamentary successions. Division and donations. Goods, property, other real rights, communion, legal ownership and actions to protect property and possession.

Prerequisites

Teaching methods

The course will be delivered in 60 lessons held in presence. Module A will last 72 hours. If necessary, 4 lessons can be carried out in asynchronous remote delivery mode (recorded lessons), at the discretion of the teacher, to deal with exceptional situations.

Assessment methods

Oral examination on the topics of the lessons and the exam text. There are no intermediate exams.
