- Theories and techniques in the engagement phase
- Theories and techniques in the assessment phase
- Theories and techniques for co-constructing and evaluating interventions with service users

C) Theory-driven social service intervention. Case studies through the critical reflection approach (Fook, 2012)

Detailed program

The course provides the theoretical, methodological and ethical foundations necessary to guide the helping process with individuals and families. In particular, the course will introduce to: a) a hybrid theoretical model, oriented by an anti-oppressive perspective, showing its practical application through case studies b) the theoretical foundations of social work interviewing according to the Rogerian approach, applying them through simulation of active listening and mirroring techniques. Case study will be used as the basis for stimulating critical reflection on the social worker's decisions at different stages of the helping process.
