Learning objectives

The this course provides students with the basic tools for understanding contemporary society and the processes of its change. Particular emphasis is given to contemporary sociological imagination and the contemporary outcomes of neoliberal modernity.

Contents

The first part, general in nature, introduces the key concepts of social science, with a focus on the history of sociological thought.

The second part, a monographic one, deepens the analysis of contemporary sociological imagination to highlight some critical aspects of it.

Dimensions of social phenomena: individuals, institutions, symbolic world.

Concepts, problems, theories.

PART TWO

Social history.

Contemporary sociological imagination: ancient and modern myths.

Teaching methods

The Course consists of 56 hours of so-called 'deliverable' teaching (so-called 'face-to-face' lectures involving - obviously - communicative exchange in the classroom)

Assessment methods

The exam is written, takes two hours and consists of the preparation of three short papers on assigned topics:

- a short essay on an indicated general topic covered by the textbook;
- a short essay on an indicated general topic covered by the monograph essay;
- a short presentation of one of the classics indicated.
