SYLLABUS DEL CORSO

Learning objectives

The aim of the course is to provide a complete basic knowledge of the discipline of organization and action of public administrations and to equip students with the tools, including methodological ones, necessary to understand and interpret administrative law in order to apply it to concrete cases, taking into account also the supranational level.

At the end of the course, the student will acquire the ability to analyze regulatory sources and jurisprudential cases, the ability to read and understand the functioning of public administrations, in addition to greater terminological precision and a more appropriate language ability, which are fundamental for developing an autonomy of judgment on current problems of administrative law.

Contents

The objective of the administrative law course is to study the administrative procedure and the activities of public authorities. Particular attention will be dedicated to the analysis of the problems that have arisen due to the deep transformations presently taking place in administrative law. This approach will likely lead to a new structural concept of administrative law, placing emphasis on the new school of thought which combines elements of both public and private law.

Moreover, this approach will be analyzed in the context of the Italian administrative justice law in order to understand the effectiveness of citizen protection when confronted with administrative power.
