### Employment Relationship Regulation

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#### Learning objectives

The course aims to provide students a critical and systematic perspective characteristics and peculiarities of work in the public service.

#### Contents

The course addresses the most significant legal elements of employment in the public service.

#### Detailed program

The programme is structured on the analysis of the most relevant elements of labour law in the public service:

- the legal sources of public employment law, with particular emphasis on collective agreements;
- the modalities of access; functions and tasks;
- staff mobility;
- flexible contracts and organisational flexibility;
- legal limits of disciplinary power;
- economic treatment;
- the management
  - forms of termination of the relationship;
- procedural rules.

## **Prerequisites**

Knowledge of private law and public law.

## **Teaching methods**

The course includes both frontal and interactive teaching (e.g. group or individual work assigned to students).

## **Assessment methods**

Final oral exam.
