The course aims to provide students with in-depth knowledge of the criminal procedural discipline concerning entities through critical analysis of the provisions of Legislative Decree No. 231 of 2001.

During the lectures, with erogative method, we will analyze the regulations governing the assessment of liability of entities for administrative offenses dependent on crime. In particular, we will look at procedural developments and evidentiary dynamics while verifying their constitutional compatibility.
