Learning objectives

The aim of the Course is to provide the student with the knowledge of fundamental principles and legal instruments to understand the structure and functioning of public administrations.

At the end of the course, the student will have acquired the knowledge of the main tools available to citizens to assert their interests in relations with public administrations, in particular in the context of administrative procedures.

Contents

The Course focuses on the analysis of legal relations between citizens and public administrations through the study of the principles and rules that inform the organization and administrative activity.
