Short description

Education, mediation, interpretation and participation within and with reference to Intangible Heritage; Participatory citizenship through the active protection of proximity heritages; Interdisciplinary and collaborative approaches to the dignity of witnessing.

All teaching is organised in the form of face-to-face lectures (didactic-erogative).

The course will include the following classical lectures and interactive learning.

Dialogue lectures (including exercises and small laboratory activities) will be used to stimulate a critical approach to the discipline and reflection on the implications of such knowledge in the process of education, mediation, participation and interpretation of the tangible and intangible cultural heritage.. During the course there will be some experts in Heritage who will share their experiences.

The course involves the completion of a dissertation at the end of the module by PhD students relating to certain topics presented in the lectures, with particular reference to the personal research question. The paper is assessed by the module lecturers as a whole and may or may not be approved.
