

COURSE SYLLABUS

Youth participation and artistic languages: theoretical and methodological perspectives in the educational field

Module description

The course module aims to promote the development of knowledge and skills concerning the main theoretical and methodological dimensions related to the use of artistic languages in the education and training of the young generation. The course emphasises the importance of involving children and young people in the decisions that affect them, in the broader context of the framework of children's and adolescents' rights and youth policies, analysed from a pedagogical perspective. The focus is on access to the cultural and artistic dimension as an essential possibility to enable expression and choice, key elements of democratic participation. The course combines theoretical reflections with presenting cases and strategies using artistic languages to foster young people's expression and participation in decision-making processes. These practices' potential and critical aspects are examined, with particular attention to the ethical aspects required to create respectful and inclusive contexts.

Learning goals

The main learning objectives of the module are:

- To understand theories and methodologies relating to the use of artistic languages in the education and training of children and young people, with particular reference to the promotion of participation
- Analysing the educational value of young people's participation in decision-making processes
- Assessing the potential and critical aspects related to the use of artistic languages in the education and training of the younger generation
- Combining theory and practice

General goal

The course aims to develop knowledge and skills regarding artistic theories and approaches in educational and training work with young people, with a specific focus on promoting their participation. The main objective is to provide students with an in-depth understanding of artistic languages as tools for the expression and active participation of young people in educational decision-making processes.

Specific skills and competences

The module aims to prepare students to understand, analyse and critically apply theories and methodologies relating to the use of artistic languages in children and youth education, with an emphasis on promoting active participation of young people in decision-making processes.
