The aim of the course is to assist students in transforming their research ideas into high-quality research outputs, including the prospectus, conference presentations, academic articles, and research projects. The course addresses how to structure a research article and respond to peer reviews, how to build a research project, how to prepare a conference presentation, and how to transition from a doctoral thesis to a monograph and publications in general. By the end of the course, students should be able to present their research questions and findings to an

academic audience; condense their ideas into concise and effective descriptions; develop a focused research project; and build confidence and competence as speakers. The course will also foster logical thinking, critical reading, and clear, simple, and engaging writing.
