Place-based education: ecological perspectives and practices

Module description

The unit aims to present the main theoretical and methodological elements of the large field of theories and experiences that are attributed to place-based education, discussing and focusing it progressively in the light of foundations and approaches proper to an ecological perspective. In this direction, the unit discusses the motivations, opportunities and forms of an educational proposal that, in declining *also* in outdoor contexts, supports an ecological awareness and thereby fosters sustainable behaviors. To this purpose, in the unit, useful experiences, modalities and issues are introduced and analyzed in order to understand in particular outdoor education in its most recent declinations and possibilities in educational services and schools.

Learning goals

The unit aims to promote knowledge of the field of experience identified as place-based education, its international and national origins and interpretations, its motivations, the main theories of reference, possible methodological approaches, and the most recent experiences in educational services and schools, so as to support the ability to recognize and foster educational and training proposals from an ecological perspective.

General goal

The overall goal of the unit is to introduce so-called place-based education from an ecological perspective.

Know how to discuss and analyze theories, methodologies and experiences in place-based education.

For those who choose to carry out the proposed e-tivities, it is possible to build the paper starting from these experiences, to be documented and analysed, putting them in dialogue with in-depth material to be agreed with the professor.
