In addition, they write clear and articulate texts on a wide range of topics of interest, write essays and reports that provide information and reasons for or against certain opinions. They can write letters that highlight the personal significance attributed to events and experiences, highlighting the aspects considered important."

During the interactive sessions, there will be discussions, group exercises and practical reading, writing and listening activities aimed at enhancing language skills, stimulating critical thinking and the ability to communicate effectively in English.
