Learning objectives

The course intends to explain the foundations of Commercial Law, with particular reference to the entrepreneur, partnerships and capital companies.

Contents

The course has its object the discipline of enterprise both individual and collective in particular it will focus, on the first part, on the different notions of enterprise on the relative disciplines, while, in its second main part, on the regulation of both partnership and capital companies.

Detailed program

Italian and EU Notion of Enterprises; Commercial, Agricultural , Public, Nonprofit and Social Enterprises, Intellectual Professions, the Law of Partnerships and Companies.

Prerequisites

Passing the Private Law Institution exam is a fundamental prerequisite.

Teaching methods

A mix of delivery teaching and interactive teaching will be adopted. The first will be responsible for providing the fundamental notions of commercial law while the second will try to develop a learning process based on the presentation and discussion of concrete cases, favoring the operational approach aimed at analyzing real cases in the light of the judicial decisions taken by the case law on the merits and legitimacy.

Assessment methods

The exam will be exclusively oral and there are no intermediate tests. The exam will focus on the contents covered in the classroom and illustrated in the reference manuals, with the aim of assessing the degree of learning of the students, their argumentative ability, the clarity of exposition and the property of language.

Textbooks and Reading Materials

Marco Cian (edited by), *Manuale di diritto commerciale*, sixth edition, Giappichelli 2025, limited to the following sections: 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12.

The student can of course choose other textbooks, provided that these textbooks explain the same topics covered in the book indicated above.
