### Professional Training in Clinical Surgery

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#### Aims

The objectives of the surgical internship are the approach to the surgical patient, the collection of medical history, the execution of an objective examination with the aim of discussing the hypotheses of differential diagnosis and therapeutic treatment.

#### Contents

During the Internship the student must acquire adequate professional preparation in the field of pathology internist and its sub-sectors with particular regard to differential diagnosis and the setting of appropriate therapeutic pathways.

#### Detailed program

Diagnostic principles and therapeutic approach of 1) colorectal diseases (including neoplastic disease, inflammatory disease, acute diverticulitis, etc.), 2) hepatobiliary diseases (neoplasms, cirrhosis etc.), 3 ) pancreatic diseases (solid and cystic neoplasms, acute and chronic pancreatitis), 4) gastroenterological diseases (peptic ulcer disease, neoplasms, hiatal hernia, GERD, etc.), 5) emergency surgery (acute appendicitis, bowel perforation/ischemia, bowel obstruction, peritonitis, trauma)
