Turning Clinical Experience Into Research Projects

Aims

To introduce clinical research practice, to give an overview about clinical and epidemiological research studies and to sharpen critical thinking in (clinical) research

Contents

The course introduces the student to the practice of clinical research with the aim to develop/sharpen critical thinking and ask good reserach questions.

Students will be involved using practical (clinical) research questions. Historical examples will be also largely mentioned to give an overview about the different steps of past and recent clinical research practice. Clinical research epidemiological design will be explained from theoretical nad practical perspective.

Students will be also involved in a individual/team work where they can develop an independent and hypothetical research questions suggested by themselves or by the lecturer.

- Historical past and recent clinical research examples
- Study design explanations: observational and experimental studies with their pros, cons and gaps also using illustrative examples
- Individual/team working group on some (clinical) research questions
