Give the indications and manage isolation of potentially infective patients in Hospital


Approach to outpatient consultation for chronic infection (HIV Hepatitis Viruses) and Lyme disease

Contents

Take part with one tutor (1:!) to the activities of the Infectious Diseases Unit in Niguarda Great Metropolitan hospital

Detailed program

- Participation with a tutor to daily consultation activity in Niguarda Hospital with specific focus on consultation in o transplanted patients,
- o haematological patients,
- o patients hospitalized in intensive care units
- o patients hospitalized in special surgical units (Neurosurgery, Plastic Surgery, TraumaTeam)
- Participation with one or more tutors to the activities of the antimicrobial stewardship program (meetings and audits) and of the group for the control of hospital infections
- Participation with the ward group to daily briefings where is discussed the diagnostic and therapeutic plan of each



• Participation with one tutor (1:1) to outpatients visits in clinics for chronic infections (HIV and viral hepatitis) and for Lyme disease
