Aims

The elective course "The Organ Donation Process: Nursing Assistance to the Potential Organ Donor Person" aims to enable students to acquire fundamental knowledge and skills on the process of organ and tissue donation and transplantation, Understanding the regulatory framework, the organization of health services, the professional roles involved and the ethical and communicative implications, with particular attention to nursing intervention and the development of a critical and conscious reflection.

The specific objectives, formulated in accordance with the Dublin Descriptors, are as follows:

1. Knowledge and understanding: understand the Italian regulatory framework and the organization of the social health system in the area of organ and tissue donation and transplantation.
2. Applied knowledge and understanding skills: apply the acquired knowledge to identify the competences and responsibilities of the professionals involved and the role of the nurse in the different stages of the process.
3. Autonomy of judgment: critically reflect on the ethical, cultural and social implications of donation and transplantation, developing an autonomous and conscious thinking.
4. Communication skills: communicate in a clear, professional and respectful way with users, family and team members, even on sensitive topics such as donation.
5. Learning ability: develop strategies to autonomously update on donation and transplantation regulations, good practices and innovations.
