Nursing Care in Intensive Neonatal Units

Aims

The elective course, "Nursing Care in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, aims to provide nursing students with advanced knowledge of caring for the neonate admitted to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit by developing an indepth understanding of the critical newborn and parenting support methodologies, such as "Single Family Rooms," to promote holistic, family-centered care.

The specific objectives, formulated in accordance with the Dublin Descriptors, are as follows:

- 1. Knowledge and Understanding

 Know the clinical complexities of the critical newborn and the "Single Family Room" model as a key
 - methodology for parental involvement in the NICU.
- 2. Ability to Apply Knowledge and Understanding
 Plan and implement evidence-based nursing care interventions for the critical newborn, applying effective
 parenting support strategies in the NICU setting.
- Autonomy of Judgment
 Critically evaluate newborn conditions and the effectiveness of family-centered care models, making autonomous judgments to optimize care outcomes for newborn and family.
- 4. Communication Skills Communicate clearly, empathetically and professionally with parents and the multidisciplinary team in the NICU, conveying complex information and offering emotional support.
- 5. Ability to Learn

 Demonstrate autonomy in continuously updating one's knowledge and critically reflecting on practice to continuously improve care for the critical newborn and his or her family.
